# Medical support & Health Care

**The Vice President of Samoon Foundation, Mr. Vijay Mohan Panyuli, presented a cheque for 11,000 INR to the family of 18- year-old Himanshu Kumar at the Samoon Head Office in Rishikesh. This amount was provided as a small assistance from the Samoon family for his kidney transplant.**



**Sunday, April 12, 2023**

The Vice President of Samoon Foundation, Mr. Vijay Mohan Panyuli, handed over a cheque of ₹11,000 to the family of 18-year-old Himanshu Kumar at the Samoon Head Office in Rishikesh as support for his kidney transplant. Himanshu, from village Pulinda in Pauri Garhwal, has been battling kidney disease for six months and surviving on dialysis. Doctors have advised a transplant costing around ₹10 lakh. Due to extreme financial hardship—his mother earns ₹1,500/month as a domestic worker and his father is a laborer—the family is unable to afford the treatment. The Samoon Foundation extended this small but meaningful help to support Himanshu's fight for life.





## Once again, financial assistance of ₹20,000 was transferred to Kailashi's account for his treatment.

**Date – Wednesday, April 29, 2023**

Kailashi, who became paralyzed after a fall in school during her 12th grade, is currently undergoing treatment in Dehradun. Her family, with no source of income and a disabled father, is unable to afford her monthly medication expenses of ₹8,000. In the financial year 2022–23, the Samoon Foundation had provided ₹17,000 for her treatment. This year again, ₹20,000 was transferred to her account as continued support. The Samoon family prays for her speedy recovery and remains committed to helping her, with heartfelt thanks to all the kind donors who make such aid possible.


**Date – Thursday, July 19, 2023**

Vikas, a member of a financially weak family, met with a serious road accident that left both of his legs fractured, making him completely bedridden and unable to work or support his household. In light of this difficult situation, the Samoon Foundation extended a helping hand by providing a cheque of ₹11,000 to assist with his medical treatment and ongoing medication expenses.

Understanding the family's urgent needs beyond just medical aid, the Foundation also arranged two months' worth of essential ration supplies to help them manage their daily living during this crisis. Furthermore, the Foundation supported the education of Vikas's daughter, Pihu, by renewing her school registration and clearing her pending school fees.

This comprehensive support ensured that while Vikas focused on recovery, his family could meet basic needs and Pihu's education would not be disrupted. The Samoon Foundation remains committed to standing with families in distress and continues its mission of supporting those in need during times of hardship.





# **A Cry for Help: Vikas Kumar's Family Struggles After Devastating Accident**

## **Tuesday, July 11, 2023**

Vikas Kumar, a driver from Kathud Village in Patti Sitonsyun, Pauri Garhwal, was living in a rented room in Rishikesh to support his wife and two children. On March 3, 2023, while returning from Gadankhal after dropping passengers, his vehicle lost control and fell into a deep gorge. Though he survived, both his legs were fractured, leaving him bedridden for three months.

The accident pushed his family into a severe financial crisis. With no income, Vikas couldn't afford medical treatment, there was no food in the house, rent remained unpaid, and his daughter's name was struck off the school register due to unpaid fees. On June 20, 2023, an urgent request for help was made to community members and the general public to support the struggling family in their time of need.

## **Wednesday, July 12, 2023**

The Samoon family provided two months' ration to Vikas's family at their home and assured further support for their daughter's admission, room rent, and medical expenses.



## Thursday, July 19, 2023

Pihu was overjoyed to return to school after her father, Vikas Kumar, had been bedridden for three months due to a road accident. The Samoon Foundation quickly stepped in, re-registering her in school, clearing past dues, and paying advance fees. They also provided ₹11,000 for Vikas's medications, two months' ration, and promised ongoing support. A total donation of ₹20,000 was received for the family, including ₹10,000 from Arvind Ji (Dubai) and ₹5,000 from Ajay Rawat Ji (Pipalkoti).

The Samoon Foundation provided ₹17,000 as assistance for Prabha Devi's treatment at PGI Chandigarh after she suffered a brain hemorrhage. The support was extended through Vice President Mr. Vijay Mohan Panyuli, following a request from her financially struggling family.



# The Samoon Foundation provided a small assistance amount of ₹16,000 for the treatment of kidney patient Mahavir Rana.

**Date: Thursday, December 7, 2023**

Mahavir Singh Rana, 32, from Soniyat village, Tehri Garhwal, is battling serious health issues—first a brain hemorrhage, followed by kidney failure. He now undergoes dialysis three times a week at AIIMS Rishikesh and has been advised a kidney transplant estimated at ₹20 lakh. To stay close to the hospital, Mahavir, along with his wife and two young children, lives in a rented room in Gumaniwala, paying ₹3,500 per month and ₹500 daily for hospital travel.

Due to the family's critical financial condition, the Samoon Foundation stepped in and provided ₹16,000 as immediate assistance for his treatment. The Foundation also assured the family of continued support in the future, standing by them during this difficult time.





**An amount of ₹1 lakh was directly transferred to the account of kidney patient Ankit by generous donors, while a check of ₹51,000 was provided by the Samoon Foundation.**

**Date: Sunday, December 17, 2023**

Ankit Meher, a 22-year-old youth from Bacheti village in Almora district, was undergoing treatment at AIIMS Rishikesh after both his kidneys failed. Despite holding big dreams for his future, his life depended on an urgent kidney transplant. His father came forward to donate a kidney, but the family lacked the financial means to afford the surgery, even with an Ayushman card. Recognizing the urgency, Samoon Foundation's senior member Hemant Nyal (Hemu Bhai), who also hails from the same village and works in Dubai, mobilized support among both Uttarakhandi and non-Uttarakhandi families in Dubai. Through these collective efforts, a total of ₹1.5 lakh was raised—₹1 lakh was directly transferred to Ankit's family by donors, and ₹51,000 was provided as a cheque by the Samoon Foundation. This united support gave hope to Ankit and his family during a critical time.








**The Samoon Family provided a small financial assistance check of ₹17,000 for the treatment of Miss Bindi, who is bravely battling a serious illness like cancer.**

**Date: Monday, February 12, 2024**

Miss Bindi, a 12th-grade student from Gairsain battling cancer at AIIMS Rishikesh, faced financial hardship due to her family's poor condition. After her mother approached the Samoon Foundation, the team promptly provided ₹17,000 on February 12, 2024, to help with travel, stay, and medicine costs, assuring further support if needed.



**The Samoon team visited an aged mother's house and took her grandson to the hospital to have his fractured leg treated, purchased medicines, provided rations for the next two months, and gave ₹1500 in cash for further medications.**

**Date: Sunday, March 17, 2024**

Samoon member Rajni Rana noticed an elderly woman begging in Rishikesh and stopped to understand her situation. The woman revealed a heartbreak story —she had lost her husband, son-in-law, and daughter-in-law, while her mentally ill son had gone missing. Left with a young grandson suffering from a fractured leg and no means to afford treatment, she was forced to beg. Samoon member Jitendra Jerdhari visited her home to verify the situation. Moved by their condition, the Samoon team provided hospital treatment, purchased medicines, delivered two months' worth of rations, and gave ₹1,500 in cash for ongoing needs, assuring the family of further support.



# Environment & Nature Conservation

**On June 18, 2023, Sunday, from 8 AM to 12 PM, the Samoon Foundation organized a cleanliness awareness rally and Ganga cleaning drive in Rishikesh. The rally began from Koyal Valley, passed through AIIMS Road, and ended on Bairaj Road. Following the rally, the banks of the river (ghats) were cleaned along Marine Drive (Aastha Path).**

**Date – Saturday, June 18, 2023**

Under India's G20 presidency, reflecting the spirit of 'Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam', the Samoon Foundation is organizing a cleanliness awareness rally in Rishikesh on June 18, 2023, under the C20 initiative. The rally will run from Koyal Valley to Bairaj Road, followed by a riverbank cleaning drive at Marine Drive. Preparations are ongoing to ensure active participation.



As part of the G20 C20 initiative, the Samoon Foundation held a cleanliness awareness rally and Ganga cleaning drive in Rishikesh on June 18, 2023. The rally ran from Koyal Valley to Bairaj Road, followed by a riverbank cleanup at Marine Drive (Aastha Path).

The Samoon Foundation, with support from team members, Rishikesh Municipal Corporation, UPES students, locals, and social workers, organized a cleanliness rally and Ganga cleaning drive in Rishikesh. Named "Swachh Bharat Ki Pavitra Ganga", the campaign aimed to raise awareness about the Swachh Bharat Mission and the need to keep the Ganga clean. Rishikesh, being the first city the Ganga enters, was chosen as the rally site to inspire people to stop polluting the river and take collective responsibility for cleanliness.
